## 2- The work step by step.

February 23 <sup>th</sup>	Translation/Understanding	The students translate a part of the text into French by group of two. They write it and send their translation to the teacher.
March 16 <sup>th</sup>	Move the text from narrative to dialogue between a journalist and an academic/historian	The students turn the text from narrative to dialogue.
March 23 <sup>th</sup>	Move the text from narrative to dialogue between a journalist and an academic/historian	The students turn the text from narrative to dialogue.
March 30 <sup>th</sup>	Recording of the dialogue	The students record their dialogue in MP3
April 6th	Preparation of the headlines of the newspaper	It will include the dialogue between the journalist and an historian.
April 13 <sup>th</sup>	Preparation of the headlines of the newspaper	The front page must contain some pictures/map/graph
April 20 <sup>th</sup>	Preparation of the headlines of the newspaper	The students can add some photograph/engraving
May 18th	Presentation to the class	The student present the interview and the front page they have done to the group
May 25 <sup>th</sup>	Presentation to the class	The student present the interview and the front page they have done to the class
